

RSS Submission sites.

Why use these RSS feed links?

When you set your blog RSS feed into these aggregator sites you will get two possible benefits.

1. You will get a backlink to your site that the search engines will find.
2. You may get visitors to your site directly from the aggregator.

The biggest benefit though is that every time you post a new article you'll get another link to your site without having to do anything more. Every link provides the same two benefits. There are 59 sites here which means you can guarantee that you'll get a minimum of 50 backlinks to every post you make without doing anything more.

What else can you do with these links?

When you set up a new website on many of the free services that are available you can use these RSS links to create automatic posts on those sites. Each of those posts can have another link back to your main site and they grow with every post you make. The RSS links also have a link back to your site, and they also have an RSS link you can submit to the RSS aggregators listed below.

See how that can grow from a single lot of work?

Why use these links?

I have personally checked each of these links and they all go to a genuine site which will accept an RSS feed URL as of 11th August 2020. The Internet is a dynamic place so any of these could change on any day, but new ones will also appear so you will always be able to find great places.
